

Chapter Conference Registration Challenge

NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO WIN.

The Chapter Conference Registration Challenge (“Challenge”) is designed to increase registration at the 2018 Net Impact Conference (“NI18”). The Challenge engages leaders from Net Impact chapters (“Participant”). By participating in the Challenge, all Participants agree to the following rules, which must be adhered to in order to participate.

Convener

This Challenge is convened by Net Impact (“Convener”, located at 1333 Broadway, Oakland, CA 94612). Net Impact is solely responsible for this Challenge.

Overview

The Challenge is a competition where eligible Participants (see General Rules below) receive credit for conference registrations completed by individuals who are affiliated with the chapter. The Challenge opens at 9:00 am PST on May 15, 2018 along with conference registration, at which time Participants begin accumulating points as registrations occur. The Challenge will conclude at 11:59 pm PM PST on October 23, 2018.

The Challenge structure is as follows: Individuals register for the conference at either <https://www.netimpact.org/ni18/register> or through a bulk reservation initiated by, or on behalf of, the chapter. Chapters are entered into this competition to collect chapter associated registrations. Chapter Presidents, or the applicable main contact(s), will be considered the official representative(s) of the chapter, and the primary point of communication during the competition and about any prizes. There are two ways to win:

1. For every 10 chapter members registered for the conference, Net Impact will reimburse a chapter with \$100 toward an event to enhance their chapter’s conference experience.
2. Special prizes and recognition will be awarded to the chapters with the highest overall NI18 attendance.

Restrictions apply. See section below.

Prizes will be paid directly to the chapter(s) either to the official representative of the chapter or directly to the chapter if a chapter bank account exists. Funds associated with competition (1) will be reimbursed. Funds associated with competition (2) will be distributed after the Challenge concludes. All funds distributed in this competition must be used on chapter activities consistent with the Net Impact mission. Net Impact does not take any responsibility for any taxes related to the prizes. Winners will be notified within 10 days of completion of the Challenge.

General Rules

Every action taken by Participants, and their chapter leaders, in conjunction with this contest must comply with local, state and federal laws. Participants, and associated chapter leaders, outside the U.S. also must comply with all applicable U.S. laws.

Net Impact will not reimburse Participants for expenses they incur in promoting NI18.

Net Impact is a non-partisan organization and does not favor or discriminate against any political party. Net Impact does not support or oppose any candidates for public office.

Participants must be respectful that they are representing Net Impact's brand and its mission during the contest and while carrying out Challenge activities. Any activities or behavior that Net Impact, at its sole discretion, deems to be inconsistent with, or in opposition to, Net Impact's message may result in disqualification from this contest.

Participants, and their chapter leaders, must abide by all college and university rules, including university licensing and copyright rules and regulations. Sanctions for such violations are the responsibility of each participating college or university based on their own rules and regulations.

Chapter leaders from Participants must be 18 years of age or older as of the date of entry; residents of Alabama and Nebraska must be 19 years of age or older, and residents of Mississippi must be 21 years of age or older as of the entry date. All Participants' chapter leaders attending a college or university in the U.S. must be currently registered as full-time students in good standing at a college or university accredited by a nationally recognized accrediting agency contained on the list published by the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Education pursuant to the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended. All Participants' chapter leaders attending college or university outside the U.S. must be currently registered as full-time students in good standing at a college or university determined by Net Impact to be recognized as appropriately accredited. Participants must also meet all other eligibility requirements as set forth herein.

Directors, officers, and employees of Net Impact, and the immediate family members of such directors, officers or employees, and persons living in the same household as such directors, officers or employees (whether related or not) are not eligible.

Prizes will only be awarded to eligible Participants. Prizes cannot be exchanged for alternate prizes except by Net Impact, which may substitute a prize of equal or greater value if the featured prize becomes unavailable. Not all prizes will be available to all Participants. Notably, Participants which are affiliated with a school not in the U.S. may not be eligible to receive the same prizes as those affiliated with a school in the U.S.

Participants, and their chapter leaders, receiving prize money or any prizes associated with the Challenge are responsible for all related tax obligations.

Net Impact reserves the right to alter the Challenge Rules in any way, at any time.

Chapter leaders from Participants agree to receive email and newsletter communications from Net Impact. Participants may opt out of receiving each type of communication upon receipt.

Restrictions

Details and limitations: Chapter attendance is tracked through the information entered during the NI18 registration process, so Participants should be sure to remind their members to enter their chapter affiliation so attendance by chapter can be tracked.

For Competition (1), maximum funding is \$300 per chapter; reimbursement will be provided post-conference for food or beverage receipts in the Phoenix, AZ area Thursday-Sunday, October 25-28, 2018. Only one expense reimbursement form will be allowed per chapter.

For Competition (2), each chapter may only receive one prize.

Disqualification

Net Impact reserves the right at its sole discretion to disqualify any Participant, school, or chapter leader, for any reason at any time throughout the contest, including, but not limited to, disqualifying any Participant and/or school where Net Impact finds a Participant to be attempting to tamper with or undermine the submission process, the website, and/or the legitimate operation of this Challenge; to violate these rules or the Challenge Rules; or to act in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner or with the intent to annoy, abuse, threaten, or harass any other person.

Net Impact can and will, at its sole discretion, disqualify and/or dock points based on any violation of the Challenge Rules, whether concrete or subjective.

Multimedia Release and Privacy Policy

Except where prohibited by law, Participants and their chapter leaders grant to Net Impact (will be confirmed in writing on request of Net Impact) and its chapter affiliates the right and permission to print, publish, broadcast, and use, worldwide in any media now known or hereafter developed, including but not limited to the world wide web, at any time or times, each participant's name, portrait, picture, voice, likeness, and biographical information for advertising, trade, and promotional purposes (including the announcement of his or her name on television or radio broadcast) without additional consideration, compensation, permission, or notification. The winners' lists will be posted on the Net Impact website at the time of announcement.

Participation in the Challenge is voluntary and Participants will not receive financial compensation of any type associated with the taking or publication of these photographs, or participation in company marketing materials or other publications.

Release and Limitations of Liability

By participating in this contest, Participants agree that Net Impact and the Related Parties will have no liability whatsoever for, and shall be held harmless by Participants against, any liability

for any injuries, losses or damages of any kind to persons, including personal injury or death, or property resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from participation in this contest or any other Challenge-related activity, from acceptance, possession, misuse, or use of the prize or entry, or any claims based on publicity rights, defamation or invasion of privacy, or merchandise delivery. Participants agree that the Related Parties will not be responsible or liable for any injuries, damages, or losses of any kind, including direct, indirect, incidental, consequential, or punitive damages arising out of access to and use of website www.netimpact.org or any other website operated by Net Impact or its affiliates, or from downloading from and/or printing material downloaded from said websites. Without limiting the foregoing, everything regarding the Challenge, including the website and all prizes, are provided AS IS without warranty of any kind, either express or implied, including but not limited to, the implied warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, or non-infringement.

Participants understand and agree that agreement of the Challenge Rules prevents Participant and their affiliated successors from bringing a lawsuit, claim or other action against Net Impact and Related Parties and from recovering monetary damages or other legal relief from Net Impact or Related Party in connection with any of the claims released above.

Selection: Each Participant will receive 1 entry. Winners will be chosen at random.

Prizes: Value of between \$100-\$500, may be cash or other. Prizes may be substituted by Net Impact.

Winner notification: Winners will be notified by email within 72 hours of the Chapter Challenge conclusion. Chapter Presidents, or the applicable main contact(s), will be considered the official representative(s) of the chapter, and the primary point of communication during the competition and about any prizes. If a chapter does not claim the prize by responding to the email within 72 hours, another chapter will be selected at random.
